The League of Women Voters of Collier County (LWVCC) continues its tradition of educating the voters. Democracy is not a spectator sport and we have an important election in September. Every registered voter in Collier County has several opportunities to vote in the September primary.

Every registered voter in Collier County will be able to vote for School Board candidates whether they live in District 1, 3 or 5.

Every registered voter in Collier County will be voting for county judge Group 6 and circuit judges in the 20th Judicial Circuit.

Registered Democrats will also be selecting their candidates for governor and attorney general for the Nov. 7 general election.

Registered Republicans will also be selecting their candidates for U.S. senator, governor and chief financial officer for Nov. 7.

Registered Republicans in District 2 will be selecting their party's candidate for County Commission for Nov. 7.

The last day to register to vote for the September primary is Monday, Aug. 7.

Early voting will begin on Aug. 21 and go through Sept. 2, excluding Sundays, from 10:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. at nine locations throughout the county.

Any registered voter in Collier County may vote absentee.
