★ ★ REGISTRATION and VOTING ★ ★

YOU MAY REGISTER IF:

- ✓ You are a citizen of the U.S.
- ✓ You will be 18 years old by Election Day (You may pre-register at age 16.)
- ✓ You have not been convicted of a felony or adjudicated mentally incompetent, without your right to vote being officially restored.

You must be registered at least 29 days before any election. Your Voter Information Card will be mailed to you.

HOW TO CHANGE VOTER INFORMATION:

You must complete a voter registration application reflecting any name change or change in party affiliation. New address information may be provided by calling 239/252-8450.

THREE WAYS TO VOTE:

- 1. Early Voting** starts 15 days prior to Election Day at designated sites. For information and sites, visit the website: colliervotes.com or call the Elections Office.
- 2. Election Day Voting:** You must vote in the Precinct where you reside, which is noted on your Voter Information Card. (Early Voting and Election Day Voting both require a photo and signature ID.)
- 3. Absentee Voting:** Any registered voter may vote by mail. To request an absentee/mail ballot, visit colliervotes.com or call 239/252-8450. The mailing of absentee ballots normally begins four weeks prior to Election Day. Voted ballots must be received in the Elections Office by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.
