



LOCAL LEGISLATORS DISCUSS PROPERTY TAX REFORM IN UPCOMING CABLE BROADCAST

Naples, FL – June 1, 2007 – The Florida legislature’s property tax reform efforts are the subject of a June 6 cable-TV broadcast co-sponsored by The Greater Naples Chamber of Commerce and the League of Women Voters of Collier County.

“Chamber Matters,” the Chamber’s monthly television program reaching 5000 households in a five-county area, will host State Senator Burt L. Saunders (representing parts of Collier and Lee counties) and State Representative Michael J. Grant (representing parts of Charlotte, Lee and Sarasota counties) responding to questions from members of the League of Women Voters of Collier County. The program will be aired on Wednesday, June 6, and rebroadcast on Wednesday, June 13, at 7:30 p.m. on Comcast channel 35 (channel 23 for former Time-Warner cable customers).

With the Florida legislature’s plan to reconvene June 12 – 22 to reduce or restructure Florida’s ad valorem tax system, citizens need every opportunity to become better informed and hear from their elected officials about this important issue.

“The character of a community is determined by the degree of participation of its citizens,” said Chamber President Mike Reagen. “We encourage members of our community to watch “Chamber Matters” this week and learn more about this area of critical concern to all of us.”

“As a nonpartisan political organization that encourages the informed and active participation of citizens in government, our goal is to encourage and empower citizens to shape better communities,” said Collier County League of Women Voters President Chris Straton. “We are pleased to work with the Chamber to provide this opportunity to hear two of our lawmakers respond to our questions about property tax reform.”
