DELINQUENCY PREVENTION IN COLLIER COUNTY
IS SUBJECT OF LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS MEETING

NAPLES, April 4—A panel of experts will talk about youth services and Truancy Court at the final general meeting of the League of Women Voters of Collier County for the season on Monday, April 20, at 12:30 p.m. Open to the public, the meeting will take place at the Collier Athletic Club.

Panelists will include Collier County Sheriff Kevin Rambosk; Dr. Dee Whinnery, Executive Director of Student Services, Collier County Public Schools; and The Honorable Ramiro Mañalich, Circuit Judge for the 20th Circuit. The program will cover the youth services offered by the Sheriff's Office, including collaborative initiatives of law enforcement, public schools, youth-related agencies and the courts.

“The League of Women Voters, through its Justice Committee chaired by Bernice Schmelz, researches the status of delinquency prevention efforts, among other issues,” said Chris Straton, president of the Collier League. “Truancy Court is a relatively new approach that seems to be meeting with a significant degree of success.”
