PROPERTY TAX PLAN IS SUBJECT OF
LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS MEETING

NAPLES, November 7—A panel of Senator Burt Saunders, County Commissioner Frank Halas and Lee County Property Appraiser Ken Wilkinson will discuss the Property Tax Reform plan recently passed by the State legislature at the November 19, 2007, meeting of the League of Women Voters of Collier County.

“This plan has been in the news for some time but voters have so many questions how it will impact the state’s ability to provide essential services while giving some tax relief to residents,” says Chris Straton, president of the Collier League. “It is expected that the plan will be on the January 29 election ballot for voters to approve or not. We are holding this meeting that is open to the public to help answer those questions.”

Senator Saunders will explain the January 29 constitutional amendment, Commissioner Halas will talk about the impact it will have on local government and Property Appraiser Wilkinson will provide a brief overview of the purpose and status of the Florida Taxation and Budget Reform Commission.

The League meeting will take place at 12:30 p.m. on November 19 at the Collier Athletic Club, 7th Avenue North in Naples.
